- ascertain child safety logistics and determine whether we require NSW Office of Children's Guardian 'Working with Children Checks' from you or any of your family member; depending on your involvement in the parish community.
- determine the suitability of ministries or parish roles; that you may volunteer for; and/or for us to invite you to participate in.

We may use the contact details you have provided to send you information and promotional materials related to our events, activities, functions and initiatives and Archdiocesan or Catholic Church updates and news, including, where you have opted in, via email or other digital communications.

We generally collect personal information directly from you.

If you do not provide us with the personal information we have requested, we may not be able to provide you with services or allow you to hold our parish voluntary roles; to the extent that they require us to collect, use or disclose personal information.

We may also disclose your personal information where we are required or authorised by Australian law to do so (including the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997* (Cth)).
